#### **Endoscopic Sinus Surgery workshop:**

The course is designed as a high-end training for sinus surgeons starting with endoscopic sinus surgery and for those who want to refresh the current state-of-the art knowledge and methods.

- One whole specimen is available for two participants (one side for each participant).
- Intensive supervision with at least one experienced supervisor for two dissection places.

#### Day 1 (15 February 2024): Basic FESS

- Handling of endoscope and camera
- Identification of the anatomical landmarks
- Uncinectomy / infundibulotomy and middle meatal antrostomy.
- Anatomy of anterior ethmoid and frontal recess.
- Anterior and posterior ethmoidectomy.
- Sphenoethmoidal recess, sphenoidotomy.

#### Day 2 (16 February 2024): Advanced FESS

- Frontal sinus drainage I, Ila
- Dissection of vessels: sphenopalatine artery.
- Dissection of vessels: anterior, posterior ethmoidal artery.
- Endonasal Dacryocystorhinostomy.
- Orbital decompression (endonasal decompression, lateral canthotomy and inferior cantholysis).
- Optic nerve decompression
- CSF repair
